#### 6. New Business:

- LRSD Board meeting update It went very well. Cory Shangreaux and Cory Bajus attended on behalf of PAC. They enjoyed the evening, which included many table group discussions.
- LRSD Meeting on blended classrooms and multi-age education Janice Morissette was one four parents that attended the November 27<sup>th</sup> panel discussion on "blended classrooms". She shared with PAC that the evening involved discussions and information about the benefits of blended classrooms. There were parents, teachers and administration on the panel to speak about blended classrooms.
- Winter Concert discussion/concerns about the Winter Concert. Issues such as a crowded venue, lining up for good seating and it being held over two evenings.

- All 7/8 students participated in the "Manitoba Youth Health Survey" today. The survey is done on a 4 year rotation, and it was first completed in 2008. All grades 7-12 students participated in the survey, unless they opted out of the survey by contacting the school or division office. Concerns were voiced about how there should have been a "signed consent form" to participate in the survey. Information about the survey was given to parents of grade 7 and 8 students through a note, a synervoice, and it was also posted on the Ecole St.Germain website.
- Staffing update Madame Barnabe will be leaving in January. At this
  time, they are continuing to look for a replacement for her position. Mr.
  Sorin will also be taking a parental leave from January until Spring Break.
- The LRSD Board announced that there will be no postings for the Assistant Superintendent or the Director of School and Community Support at this time.
- Discussion/Idea brought forward about having a "focus discussion" at one
  of the PAC meetings regarding: "Winter Concert", as well as "the passing
  on of important information from the school to the parents" as these were
  two concerns brought forward by parents. This idea will be discussed
  again at the January PAC meeting, and a date may be chosen.
