The 5 solutions were:

- 2. Change McDowell to a French Immersion school
- 3. Change D.W. Penner to a French Immersion school.
- 4. Victor Wyatt to become a 5-8 school
- 5. Reconfigure all south end schools to grades K-4, 5-8.

Discussions were had around all of these solutions at table groups. The timing of this change was discussed. See below:

- January will be the Superintendent's recommendations to the board.
