 - Ipad project Mme Lynn Fajardo A handout was distributed that outlined how iPads would be beneficial to students at ESG. For

example, the iPads would be used in classrooms for projects such as: a Video Newsletter, podcasts, and motion animation. They would also be used to enhance learning French as an additional language. Mme Engbrecht would be trained and would like to use them in the music classroom.
