

Welcome to the High School Driver Ed Program

Manitoba's High School Driver Education Program has a proud history of helping prepare young Manitoba drivers for the road. Our courses are taught by approximately 300 instructors at 170 high schools across Manitoba. The program is open to all students who attend a Manitoba high school on a full-time basis. As a student, you pay \$50 for the course and Manitoba Public Insurance covers the rest of the costs (approximately \$350 per student).

Course overview

The Driver Education course includes 34 hours of classroom instruction, eight hours of driving and eight hours of in-car observation. You must be at least 15 ½ years of age to qualify for a learner's permit under this program.

Register for courses at any Autopac agent

Beginning May 9, 2011, you can sign up for Driver Education courses that start in the summer and fall of this year in two easy steps:

- 1. Go to mpi.mb.ca to view a list of available courses.*
- 2. Go to your nearest Autopac agent to get set up as a customer, register and pay for your course.

Look for schedules for courses beginning in January 2012 to be posted in early November 2011.

Select course location and time

All course information will be posted online at mpi.mb.ca, giving you access to a wide range of start dates and locations. You can also find out immediately if the course you wish to take is full. If that happens, you will be given priority for the next term or you may be able to take the course at another school. *

Identification requirements

The enclosed *Establishing your identity* brochure provides a list of acceptable documents for getting set up as a Manitoba Public Insurance customer. Please read this brochure and remember to take your identity documents when you go to register at any Autopac agent. Your agent is available to provide further information.

Convenience and flexibility

The Driver Education Program offers you one-stop convenience. You can establish your identity, register, select courses and pay in one visit to any Autopac agent.
