The guard.me Card

- Keep a copy of the e-card with you at all times. It is your proof of your insurance (but, bring other ID with you when you visit a clinic or hospital)
- The front of the card shows the full name as it is listed in our system, the start and end date of your policy. Its important that your period of coverage is always up to date.

The 1-800 number on the back of the card can be used by pharmacists or dentists if they have questions about your student's coverage





Make a hard copy of the e-card. Save it to your phone too – it is normal for a clinic or hospital to ask for ID to validate your identity

Print a few copies of this claim form to take with you to a clinic, it has your card at the top and the claim information section

> Please <u>REMEMBER</u> to tell us why you needed to see a doctor and attach the receipts and records

This form also has important billing information that some clinics can submit on your behalf

guard.me @ School Plan Exclusions

The following things are NOT covered by your guard.me policy:

Treatments that are not medically required (elective treatment)

Pre-existing conditions

Non-prescription or herbal medications

Expenses in your home country

Maintenance visits to the dentist, cleaning/scaling, elective procedures

Hazardous activities, such as skydiving, bungee jumping, motorized sports etc.

Operating a motorized vehicle in an area where a licence is required





Healthcare in Canada

MINOR PROBLEMS

Go to a doctor's office (family doctor), campus clinic or walk-in clinic *(our website* has a handy Find a Local Clinic feature) **OR**

Use the mobileDOCTOR app (more details later)

EXAMPLE PROBLEMS:

Sore throat, runny nose, cough, cold, flu Small aches and pains; mild fever (under 38.8°C / 102°F) Minor rashes, skin irritations Diarrhea or vomiting for 24+ hours





Healthcare in Canada

MAJOR PROBLEMS

Go to Emergency Room at the Hospital (sometimes called "Urgent Care")

EXAMPLE PROBLEMS: Broken bones Bad cut, excessive bleeding Injury from a traffic accident High fever (over 38.8°C / 102°F) Severe pain or severe illness Loss of consciousness



- Claims may be mailed


Reimbursement methods:




NEW prepaid debit
Mastercard (virtual / online or hard copy, upon request)
Direct deposit, bank wire transfer, or cheque

10 business days to process a completed claim – from the date received









Reimbursement information (who do we pay)



Original / scanned invoices from the healthcare provider



Reason for the visit (issue or diagnosis)

Receipts showing proof of payment

Your signature (or your guardian's) and the date



Third Party Liability





"TPL" provides insurance for the student and Homestay family against:

- legal liability for bodily injury up to \$1,000,000
- lawsuits for liability from unintentional accidents; legal costs reimbursable up to \$50,000
- property damage arising from personal actions

The Host Family must have valid personal Homeowner's Insurance coverage.

In most cases, the Host Family should submit claims to their personal Homeowner's or Renter's Insurance Policy first. With proof of an eligible claim guard.me will reimburse the Homeowner up to \$1,000 to cover their deductible.
