Themes

The summer's International Student Program is a two or threeweek long course designed to offer international students the chance to experience Canadian culture. Each week revolves around a theme:

Week 1 - Introduction to Canadian/Winnipeg Culture

Week 2 - Canadian History: People, Places, Animals

Week 3 - Sports, Health and Nutrition



Activities

Students will participate in a variety of academic activities and field trips. A sample of the course programming includes:

Identity flag: Students will create unique flags to represent their interests, ideas, and traits.

Currency unit: Students will learn about Canadian money and visit the Canadian Mint.

French community: We will take a walking trip through St. Boniface to visit its many attractions and discuss the importance of the French community to Canada and Winnipeg.

Canadian citizenship: An overview of some of the concepts of Canadian citizenship, including democratic values.



Activities

Global identity: What is Canada's role in relation to the larger world? How does globalization bring us together or keep us apart? How can we work together across borders?

Traditions: We will explore unique Canadian traditions and those of students and their families.

The digital world: Students will use technology at the school's computer lab to create digital media projects such as movies and/or podcasts.
