Career Trek (Gr. 6): \$1500

- Around for many years
- Usually done onsite at U of W and U of M and Red River Collegiate
- Selects about 7 students available for 20 Saturdays to open the doors to children who may have barriers to post-secondary
- This year, Career Trek is offering a virtual to an entire grade 6 class, in English for a couple weeks in February (few hours a day).
- The Division will cover the cost of one grade 6 class
- Should we use the money that PAC earmarked for babysitting course for the second grade 6 class?

Covid Information

Code Red

- Schools remain in orange
- If school goes to Red critical service worker children in k to six would be allowed onsite in class. Other students get remote
- For grade 7 and up there is no such provision. However, if a child cannot be left home a lone because it is a risk to them or other pronounced needs, the school may have flexibility for insight learning
- Temporary Apprendre chez soi (remote learning)
 - A small number of families want to pursue but the challenge is staffing
- Music and PE
 - Can use the gym again
 - The stage is for music
 - Change room is storage
 - Staff room has become student services
 - Now we have latitude in doing PE in building
 - Right now outside probably stay outside until January.
 - Gym is being used for music

Staffing info

- We have a 4/5 class with two half time teachers but one has gone to remote, and other full into the classroom
- Mme. Bridgette is .73 in music and has increased to 1.0 and is dedicating the other .27 to literacy and numeracy support
- In grade 7 / 8 added adapted Practical Arts teacher from Nelson (French) in the building
- All staff is adapting, flexible, taking on new dimensions to roles
- All hands on deck amazing place to be right now.

Discussion re Principal's Report

• (Reconfiguration) Discussion regarding challenging to children that with going to code red teachers may shift again and hard on relationships

- Division does not want to have one teacher teaching remote and in class at the same time the philosophy does not work
- Critical workers can choose between remote and in class learning
- Online teaching will be done by the staff at HB in code red
- Will there be more structure to the remote learning this time? It will not be structured like school. It will be tough.
